

# **CHAPTER 7**

## **TRANSPLANT WAITING LIST**

**AUSTRALIA**

The number of patients receiving dialysis who were on the transplant waiting list at 31<sup>st</sup> December 2004 was 1,534, 19% of the 7,952 patients dialysing, (compared to 21% at 31<sup>st</sup> March 2004). Among the States, the proportion of patients on dialysis awaiting transplantation ranged from 31% in the ACT to 6% in the Northern Territory (fig 7.1).

Of those on the waiting list; 1,243 (81%) were waiting for their first transplant and 291 had received a previous transplant (fig 7.1).

The highest proportion awaiting transplantation was among satellite haemodialysis (38%), followed by home haemodialysis (25%), hospital haemodialysis (15%), automated peritoneal dialysis (12%) and continuous ambulatory peritoneal dialysis (10%) (fig 7.4).

In the age group <65 years, 1,431 (33%) of 4,340 patients were on the waiting list. The State ratios ranged from the ACT (48%), New South Wales (45%), Queensland (18%) and the Northern Territory (7%) (fig 7.3). These proportions need to be interpreted in the light of different transplant rates between States, and different acceptance and allocation criteria.

Of the age group <55 years, 1,030 (38%) of 2,681 patients were on the waiting list. The proportion in

each State ranged from the ACT (58%), New South Wales (51%), Victoria (45%), Western Australia (31%), Tasmania (26%), Queensland (24%), South Australia (23%), and the Northern Territory (7%).

Of the 1,431 patients <65 years on the waiting list in Australia at 31<sup>st</sup> December 2004, 90 (6%) were Aboriginal/Torres Strait Islander patients, residing in the Northern Territory (81%), Western Australia (21%), Queensland (9%), New South Wales, the ACT and South Australia (all 4%) and Victoria (1%).

**NEW ZEALAND**

There were 1,770 patients dialysing at 31<sup>st</sup> December 2004, with 313 (18%) on the transplant waiting list. Eighty three percent (261) of patients were waiting for their first transplant (15% of all patients on dialysis).

Of patients <55 years old, 223 (31%) of 724 patients and <65 years old, 286 (24%) of 1,195 patients were on the transplant waiting list.

There were 64 (22%) Maori patients, 46 (16%) Pacific People and 15 (5%) Asians <65 years old, on the waiting list (fig 7.3).
