

PANCREAS DONATION

In Australia in 2015, there were 45 pancreas transplant recipients, 43 were recipients of simultaneous kidney/ pancreas transplants and two were pancreas alone transplants. The 45 pancreas transplants was an increase of 29% since 2009.

New Zealand performed 3 pancreas transplants in 2015 compared to 2 pancreas transplants in 2014.

Figures 9.1 and 9.2 show the outcomes of request for pancreas donation in Australia and New Zealand for 2015 respectively.



Figures 9.3 and 9.4 show the number of recipients of pancreas transplants by donation pathway in Australia and New Zealand respectively from 1998 to 2015. Figures 9.5 shows the number of recipients of pancreas transplant recipients by Australia and New Zealand in 2014 to 2015.



New Zealand 1998-2015




PANCREAS DONORS

The age distribution of donors providing transplanted pancreas for Australia and New Zealand is shown in Figures 9.40 and 9.41 respectively.




NON RETRIEVED PANCREAS

In 2015, there were 193 pancreas not retrieved from Australian donors and 35 from New Zealand donors. For those pancreas not retrieved in Australia, 84 were not medically suitable, 54 due to age of donor, 19 due to no suitable recipient being available, 17 due to logistical issues, 7 a result of DCD donation, seven surgically unsuitable and 5 due to trauma to the organ. In New Zealand, pancreas were not retrieved due to the age of donor (18), no suitable recipient being available (2), not medically suitable (11) and four a result of trauma to the organ.

One hundred and twenty one donors in 2015 had pancreas retrieved in Australia, however 34 of those were not for the purpose of organ transplantation but rather retrieved for research purposes. In New Zealand, 3 pancreas retrieved from donors were used for research purposes.

Table 9.1 shows the reasons pancreas were not used from Australian and New Zealand deceased donors since 2010.
